For publishers submitting to the Bukhman International Booker Prize 2027



Do you have a question? Please read the rules and the below document carefully before you email internationalsubmissions@bookerprizefoundation.org

If you still need assistance, we will get back to you as soon as possible but please note that the inbox is very busy, especially around submission deadlines.

Q: We won't have finished hard copies ready to send ahead of the submission deadline, what do we do?

A: Please send proof copies instead. Spiral bound/A4 bind-ups are also accepted if the proof is in early stages. We cannot send a submission to the judges until we have a PDF and a hard copy of the submission to ensure judges can choose their preferred format and the process is accessible as possible.

Q: We won't have proof copies ready to send ahead of the submissions deadline, what do we do?

A: Please contact internationalsubmissions@bookerprizefoundation.org as soon as possible to let us know that proof copies will be delayed. In your email please tell us when you expect to have proof copies available. This will help us to plan for submissions arriving later in the judging process and determine whether we can accept the submission.

Q: Where do we send 10 hard copies of our submission?

A: To our account at Parallel – the address is in the rules and below as a reminder. Please ensure you clearly note the Bukhman International Booker Prize 2027 on the address label (or on the invoice label if you are transferring from your own account within Parallel).

Q: We have previously sent 10 proof copies and we now have finished copies available, should we send 10 finished copies too?

A: Yes please! All finished copies get sent to the judges to replace the proof copies they been sent previously. They are always keen to consider finished copies ahead of their longlist decision and it is hugely helpful for our photography should your book be longlisted.

Q: Can we send you a late submission?

A: Any late submissions are considered on a case-by-case basis and are not guaranteed.

- Please have the additional assets and hard copies ready to send to us too – we will confirm via email if we can accept a late submission.
- If you have missed the second submission deadline for titles published between 1 December 2026 and 30 April 2027 the [submission form](#) will be closed. Please email internationalsubmissions@bookerprizefoundation.org to let us know the book title, author and translator/s and the publication date.
- Please have the additional assets and hard copies ready to send to us too – we will confirm via email if we can accept a late submission.

Q: How do we know if our [submission form](#) has been received?

A: Your submission contact email address will receive an auto response from JotForm with the subject line: 'We have received your response for the Bukhman International Booker Prize 2027'. It will also contain a copy of all the answers submitted in the [submission form](#).

Q: Can we update a detail on our [submission form](#)?

A: Yes! Please email internationalsubmissions@bookerprizefoundation.org and clearly state the book title, author and translator/s of the submission you would like to update. We will respond in due course to confirm the details have been updated.
